## **Ways to get involved**

### **Shelter Donation Drive**

Gather your friends and hold your own event to collect items that HFAR are in need of. You can look at our wish list or things that you can think of on your own. You can do this through your church, school, or other organization. You may also decide to get a local business involved by hosting an event outside their location. If you decide to have a donation drive and would like for us to bring puppies, please give us notice to plan for this event.

### **Fundraising**
