If you are needing volunteer hours for scholarships or other type of programs, you can foster animals in our care. Animals that come from foster homes are a lot more social, they have better manners, and they are easier to adopt out. - ◆ Advertise in high schools, PTO meetings, and Girl Scout/Boy Scout meetings.
- ◆ The average length of time for each foster is four to six weeks unless it is a foster that just had babies.
- ◆ The Teen Foster Program is open to teens who meet these requirements:
 - Care about and want to help animals
 - At least 16 years old
 - Parent is an approved foster, if not approved already they will need to fill out the foster application and foster agreement.
 - Parent or guardian must help with the foster animals
